



**Manly Interchange, Sydney NSW**

In early 1997 Tract won a design competition for the redevelopment of the transport interchange at Manly Wharf. Tract was appointed principal consultant for the project team.

The project objective was to provide a more convenient, safe and enjoyable environment for travellers, visitors and residents in that part of the town centre. The scheme reduced traffic congestion, enhanced pedestrian amenity and improved the level of bus services.

The works included the provision of a pedestrian plaza and a new Visitor Information Centre at the Manly Wharf forecourt. New bus shelters and public amenities were constructed as part of the works.

The project is a significant one for the Manly community, and the design process involved more than two years of consultation.

Construction commenced in May 1999 and was completed by June 2000. The construction value was \$6m.
